March 1, 2018

Our annual membership meeting was held on November 10, 2017 at the Hibernian Hall. Congratulations to James Bello, Kelly Whiteley, Kim Zebrowski and Tim Morris on being elected to the Frog Hollow Board of Governors for a 3 year term. The Board has also voted to have Dee DeTullio and Frank Farrell as our alternate board members. Heather Kall Kauffman replaced Dan McCrone as a board member in January 2018.

The Board had their first meeting and held the election of officers:

**2018 Dues Rates:** Family- \$600.00, Single \$420.00, Senior Citizen \$360.00 (age 65), Associate \$360.00. Dues are due April 1st. A \$25.00 monthly late fee will be added after April 30<sup>th</sup>. A \$50 fee will be assessed for any bounced checks.

Let us know ASAP if you plan on resigning so your bond may be given to a waiting family. If you resign after April 1<sup>st</sup>, you will be assessed monthly late fees and your bond refund will be decremented accordingly.

**WORK BOND-** \$150.00 must be paid by all members excluding senior citizens. Please indicate on the enclosed sheet if you will be working your hours and date your Work Bond check for Sept. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018. This will be shredded after 6 or more hours have been completed and approved by the board. If you do not plan on working your hours please include the check with your dues.

**NO DUES WILL BE ACCEPTED without a completely filled out membership form with the information of every individual associated with your bond, this includes associates. We will also not accept dues without a separate work bond check (Senior and Associate members excluded) dated Sept 1, 2018. Even if you do something for the club every year to cover your bond we still need a check, NO EXCEPTIONS. If these requirements are not met, you will not have access to the club until they are and will be charged a \$25 administration fee PLUS any late fees that may occur.**

**Work Parties-** are every Saturday starting April 7th, usually from 9am- noon. Please bring rakes, gloves etc. Please check email or our Frog Hollow Members page on Facebook for work party updates.

**Badges-** All members were assigned new badges in 2016. **Badges MUST be shown at the Entrance Hut Daily in order to be permitted on the grounds.** This will be strictly enforced. We ask for your patience when checking in and that you wear your badges daily. If your badge is lost there will be a \$5 fee per badge to replace them.

**Swim Tests-** All children 16 & under both returning and new members and guests will be required to pass a swim test in order to receive a swimmers badge or wristband for guests. The test will consist of 4 concurrent laps in the deep end followed by 2 minutes of treading water. **If you have already passed our swim test you do not need to retake it.**

**Insurance waivers** must be signed by all bondholders including the names of spouses and children. These will be available at the Entrance Hut. All new members must sign. Guests will also be required to sign, guests under 18 will require a parent signature or member over 18. **If you already have a waiver on file with us it does not need to be filled out again.**

#### **Guests and Parties**

Guest Fees will remain the same for the 2018 Season. Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays are \$10.00 per person, the weekday rate is \$7.00 and the Party Rate is \$5.00 per person\*\*. **All parties MUST be booked in advance only if the bondholder's dues and Work Bond are paid in full and we have your completed paperwork.** Due to the large number of requests for the Picnic Pavilion, it will be limited to 1 party per bond holder for the 2018 season and must be reserved with a \$75 deposit in advance. There will also be an additional \$100 security deposit for **ALL** parties, once you have cleaned up after your party, the manager on duty will return this check. Additionally, all parties must end by 8:30pm- if you are not out by 9:00pm you will forfeit your deposit. **There will be a minimum of \$75.00 fee for any booked party including picnic sites. Picnic sites are not booked for parties on weekends.** Your party request will be confirmed by email, please do not assume you have the date or reserved area until you receive a confirmation email. **All parties over 50 people must be Board approved.** Party Reserve will open on **May 1st** and will be booked in the order received. Booking parties will **ONLY** be done by email, please email frogpartyreserve@gmail.com.

**Frog Hollow Swim & Tennis Club will open for the season on Saturday May 26th, 2018.** All members should meet at 12 noon under the pavilion for our first membership meeting. Please remember no guests are permitted on opening day. **Any bondholder whose dues, work bond checks and Membership Form are not paid/completed will not be allowed to use the facilities.** All other information will be included in your opening day envelopes. **Please visit our web site [www.froghollowswim.com](http://www.froghollowswim.com) for information on programs, swim tests, swim team, dive team and other general information.**
